### Temporary university closure to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19

The governor of Kagawa Prefecture has requested all universities in the prefecture to close based on the Act on Special Measures for COVID-19.

As such, Kagawa University (with the exception of the Faculty of Medicine and the University Hospital) will be temporarily closed from April 25 to May 6.

During this period, we ask everyone to avoid going outside unless absolutely necessary, and strictly refrain from going back to your home prefectures, sightseeing, or travelling across prefectures. We ask for your understanding and awareness that these measures are for the safety of yourselves and those around you, and act accordingly.
